

ARTISTS-IN-RESIDENCY PROGRAM

Music

Candidate's profile

This residency program is designed principally for non-French musicians, who wish to undertake a production, research or training residence in Paris.

Candidates must

- Have Completed their initial training
- Have started a professional activity
- Be younger than 35 years old

Residency location

Situated in Paris, the Cité internationale universitaire de paris is an international residence for students, researchers and artists of more than 120 nationalities. It includes 37 houses distributed in a wooded park with collective facilities: a library, cultural activities, sport activities, a language lab system, and restaurants. It is a place for exchange between cultures, of intellectual debate and creation.

In charge of the present residency program, Théâtre de la Cité internationale is Well known by the Parisian audience. It presents the contemporary creation in performing and visual arts.

Residence Facilities

All expenses related to housing, workspace and meals must be dealt with by the musicians who must find their own financial resources.

- room with bathroom – 482€/month
- rehearsal studios – 52 €/ 30h without a piano; 56 € /30h with a piano – (flexible hours)
- triplex - accommodation (30m²) with small soundproof booth – 645 € /month.

The musicians accepted at the Cité internationale universitaire de Paris benefit from personalized support throughout their stay. Logistic and administrative help is available as well as information on the Parisian musical activities.

Resident musicians have the possibility (on special selection) to present their work to the public.

Duration of stay

From 3 to 9 months maximum, between October 1st 2009 and June 30th 2010.

Selection process

The candidates are selected by a jury consisting of representatives of the cité internationale universitaire de Paris, of cultural partners and of professionals from the Parisian musical scene. **The final results will be sent to each applicant by mail** (no phone call will be answered to)
